Melbourne Instruments announces new features and extended Early Bird Offer for NINA synthesizer

Additional VCO per voice

Melboure Instruments has today revealed that NINA will now offer **2 analog VCOs per voice**, an upgrade over the previous announcement of 1 analog VCO and 1 FPGA oscillator. Each voice's second oscillator will now be selectable between an analog VCO or an FPGA oscillator.

The first small batch of production units includes this new upgrade, and will be on show at Synthplex 2022, commencing today at the Marriott Convention Center, Burbank, California.

Melbourne Instruments has extended the NINA Early Bird Special until November 14, 2022. The Early Bird Special entitles purchasers to a \$US500.00 discount off the RRP (\$US3500+ local taxes). From November 15, 2022 onwards, NINA will return to the full RRP.

- Patch morphing between 2 sounds of all settings including the mod matrix.
- A powerful modulation matrix that gets very close to the anything-to-anything ideal, with unlimited bus connections. (16 sources to 27 destinations)
- Interactive mod matrix setup mode using the motorized controls.
- · Large amount of overdrive possible.
- · Useful and expressive haptic feedback when using the knobs.
- · Hackable open source software.
